Introduction

The v1.0.53 ezMaster is the final version of version 1 ezMaster. The version will be provided the newly functions to enhance the application on management of multi-accounts and Hotspot 2.0 beta, as well as to fix bugs.

What's New?

This version has been supported the following new functions,

1. Account Management Enhancement
 - A) Add Idle Timeout mechanism: Default is 5 mins; Max. is 60 mins.
 - B) Add Online User List: Admin can review the online users via the list.
 - C) Export Online user list as a CSV file.
2. Hotspot 2.0 Beta
 - A) Enable the function to proceed the hotspot 2.0 service with ISP/WISP.
3. Enable / Disable 802.11ax wireless mode under 2.4GHz
4. WPA3 Configuration
5. Device List Refresh
 - A) Default is disabled. Admin can select the update interval as manually, 5 mins, 10mins, 15mins, 20mins, and 30mins.
 - B) The option can be found at system section under Global setting.
6. New Added countries
 - A) Kazakhstan
 - B) Latvia
 - C) Estonia
 - D) Lithuania
 - E) North Macedonia

Supported Devices

To ensure compliance with ezMaster v1.0.53 on new functions including WPA3, Hotspot 2.0 and Enable/Disable 11ax under 2.4GHz radio, the Access Point f/w should be upgraded to the v3.7.0 or the later version. The legacy models will not be supported the new function.
